

"My little planet" challenges

What is "My little planet"?

It is a French non-profit organisation that offers environmental challenges to different actors including schools! United Schools is a partner of MPP because we share the same values and are complementary. A video **<u>HERE</u>** to have more details.

How does It work?

Twice a year (in **March** and **November**), we invite you and your students to participate in the "MLP" eco-friendly challenges. This lasts 3 weeks.

You will create a league (your class or group) and then small teams of a few students. Through play, they will motivate each other to achieve great challenges for the planet. Some examples:

- **Pick up** a piece of rubbish anywhere and throw it in the right bin + 4pts
- Cooking vegetables with someone you know + 4pts
- Making/repairing an object yourself or having it repaired + 5pts
- **Make a proposal** to the head teacher to make the school more environmentally friendly + 10pts
- More than 40 other challenges to discover...

Good news, if you are 8-10 years old, you are already responding positively to one of the challenges: "connect with other schools in the world"!

How to get started?

1/ Get all the information **HERE** and register for the next session (in February for the March session and October for the November session) thanks to this link **HERE**.

2/ Start a group conversation with, depending on the age of your students, the parents or the students inside. Several tools are possible and this is specified at registration. It will allow you to mobilise the pupils and sometimes their parents in the adventure!

3/ Sign up for one of the proposed "training" meetings (45mn) to give you all the keys to succeed in the challenges with your pupils.

4/ Start the challenges, with your pupils, at the official launch!
