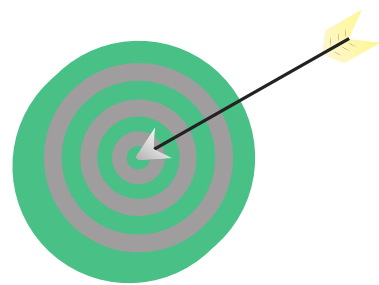

## Contribute to United Schools anthem

### Material

Instructions and resources are provided below.

The minimum required is a smartphone to record the video and forward it to United Schools.

### Objectives

- Creating a feeling of belonging in an international pupils community (we don't speak the same language but we have the same anthem)
- Promoting dialects
- Highlighting pupils' talents (writing, singing, dancing, etc.)

### Description

United Schools anthem has been created in 2018. Since then, 6 schools in 5 countries have been adding lyrics!

If you have a music teacher in your school, don't hesitate to call for help!

Each class can add a couplet in any language. Some pupils can look after writing lyrics whilst others could set up a choreography or play musical instruments.

Lyrics must contain United Schools themes such as cultural behaviours, sustainable development...

The length should be around 20 seconds.

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## Instructions

### Here are detailed instructions to contribute to US anthem. Enjoy!

1. Watch the current anthem **HERE** and start thinking about lyrics with your pupils
2. Download and listen to the melody without lyrics **HERE**. Find the correct tempo to make sure the synchronisation with other classes videos will work.
3. Record pupils voice first. Please note that the melody shouldn't be recorded. Therefore, ask your students to sing without song (or at a very low level). Ideally, the couplet should be between the 11th and 33rd second of the melody without lyrics, provided above.
4. Film your pupils whilst singing. This time, focus on the video, that's why you can help them with the music.
5. Send those 2 files (voice and video) to United Schools team via an email. If it is heavy, you can use WeTransfer (<http://wetransfer.com>) or Google Drive.
