Goals

- Open students' minds to the various issues related to the SDGs according to each territory (country, city)

- Encourage students to take part in their learning

Supplies needed

Description

You have the honor to represent your school for this great international event. The UN has defined 17 Sustainable Development Goals and each of them is part of the solution to living better together.

Today you have the chance to present your initiatives and thoughts for a better world!

Instruction

Students will be divided into 4 subjects represented by 4 SDGs :

- * **Reduced Inequality** (SDG 10)
- * **Sustainable Cities and Communities** (SDG 11)
- * **Climate Action** (SDG 13)
- * **Peace and Justice Strong Institutions** (SDG 16)

Throughout the school year, the main goal is to carry out actions in favor of these 4 sustainable development objectives.

Like the great athletes who train for months for the Olympic Games, the class have plenty of time to prepare for the big closing ceremony which will take place in June (the week of the 23th of june, World Olympic Day). You can post online your reflexions and your outcomes, in the form of articles, photographic reports or videos on the platform.

At the end of theses months of work, the week of the 23th of june will be dedicated in posting online the outcome of all your projects. Then, each class will have to vote for their favorite project for each category (conditions given later).

Various rewards will then be given to the winners, according to 3 criteria:

- Originality (kind of innovation)
- Efficiency (can be implemented elsewhere easily)
- Conception (a great idea although difficult to achieve in time and space)
